Mr. Bernstein stated that it sounded like a 2-for. It sounded like, beyond Standards-Based Report Card, they were presenting curriculum mapping, in fact, very detailed, beyond supporting consistency in assessments. Ms Angelakis and Ms. Longin confirmed that, indeed, the solution does cover curriculum mapping. Mr. Bernstein additionally noted that the database seemed to provide the basis for detailed analysis of the data. Ms. Angelakis, Ms. Longing and Mr. Kaczynski confirmed that the database supported a wide range of queries and reports. Reports can be tailored for students, parents, teachers, and administrators. Mr. Bernstein congratulated them on significantly exceeding expectations, with both curriculum mapping and a database that lent itself to extensive interrogation.

Dr. Malone mentioned that they had developed the Standards-Based Report Card after extensive research, reviewing approximately 30 different report cards. They had found the Dover and Sherbrook examples particularly helpful.
